## **Our approach to cancer is personalized for each patient.**

*Cancer is a complex disease with many types and subtypes, so our team designs a comprehensive treatment plan specific to that individual.*

*We have made access to care a priority. Appointments that typically may take a few weeks to schedule elsewhere can often be completed in a matter of days – and that means less anxiety and greater continuity of care.*

### **Medical Oncology Services**

- Expert diagnosis, treatment and management of solid tumors (breast, lung, colon, prostate cancers, etc.)
- Chemotherapy treatment and management
- Palliative care, including pain management



### **Reconstructive Surgery**

To ensure that patients have the most options, we include breast reconstruction as part of the treatment plan from the beginning.

### **Hematology Services**

Our X-ray department uses the latest technology to make an accurate diagnosis, and provides ongoing evaluation and follow-up with CT, PET and MRI all located on site - eliminating the need to run from office to office.



### **Chemotherapy/Treatment Center**

Based on input from patients, CancerCare was planned with private and semi-private rooms. The treatment area is just steps from our state-of-the-art pharmacy, which dispenses chemotherapeutic agents and supportive care medications for each patient.

Chemo services are offered five days each week.

- ✓ Chemotherapy
- ✓ Procrit, Neupogen and Neulasta injections
- ✓ Iron infusion
- ✓ Port flushes and maintenance
