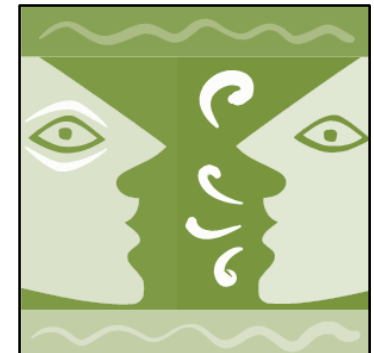

## Adult Services

### Dysphagia Therapy

*Patients complaining of choking on foods or liquids, difficulty with eating, weight loss, or recurrent pneumonia may have a swallowing disorder.*

#### Diagnosis & Treatment

- Clinical evaluation and treatment on an outpatient basis
- Videofluorographic swallow studies in cooperation with the Radiology Department to further diagnose the symptoms
- Inpatient dysphagia evaluation and treatment as needed

### Communication Therapy

Communication Therapy can be beneficial for a wide range of conditions, including

- Stroke
- Brain tumor
- Parkinson's Disease
- Dementia
- Progressive neurological disease processes (ALS, MS, CP, etc.)
- Cancer
- Head Injury



*Therapy is provided for listening skills, expressive and receptive language skills, word-finding difficulty, speech clarity, reading and writing skills, as well as cognitive retraining, including memory and dementia issues.*

## Pediatric Services

Speech, Language and Swallowing  
Diagnosis and treatment are provided for multiple needs.

- Articulation
- Phonological processing
- Expressive and receptive language disorder
- Fluency
- Auditory processing
- Oral-motor dysfunction/feeding
- Augmentative communication
- Voice
- Social/pragmatics disorders

Therapists have experience with a variety of disorders. They work closely with parents to determine specific goals, type of intervention, and focus of therapy for a variety of conditions, such as

- Autism and other sensory-based communication disorders
- Down Syndrome
- Apraxia
- Hearing Loss



*Individual or group therapy is available for children from birth to age 18*
